Flexibility (considering and respecting different social realities)


- Integration and harmonization of ongoing actions and projects.

The intended developing program to be implemented aims to reconcile human activities and the environment.

Looking after the commitments regarding to the Sustainable Development Goals stated at the United Nations 2030 Agenda, the Aichi Targets and other Multilateral Environment Agrements - MEAs, the Brazilian proposal for Ecological Corridors strenghten the National System of Conservation Units and is based on six drivers:
